



## Directions to Winchcombe Farm CV35 0TH

We are a little tricky to find due to our remote rural location; sat navs tend to bring you quite close but not directly to the end of our drive. The 'What3Words' reference or co-ordinates above should get you directly to the end of the driveway.

### From the North:

- Travelling south down the M40, at Junction 12 take the B4451 exit to Gaydon.
- Turn left onto Gaydon Rd/B4451.
- At the second traffic lights turn left towards Gaydon.
- At the small roundabout turn left on to the B4100 towards Banbury, passing the petrol station on your left.
- Continue for approximately 2 miles, passing Temple Herdewyke.
- Immediately after the army base, turn right into Gosport Lane.
- At the T-Junction, turn left onto the B4086 towards Edgehill.
- At the next T-junction turn right onto the A422 towards Stratford.
- As the A422 goes into a sharp right hand bend, take the left turning into Sugarswell Lane.
- Follow this road until you come to a staggered crossroads and take the right hand turning into Shenington Lane.
- As the road descends, look out for the right hand turning on the bend to Winchcombe Farm.

### From the South:

- Travelling north up the M40 at Junction 11, take the exit towards Banbury A422 (A361).
- At the next three roundabouts take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit staying on the A422 passing Tesco's and Banbury Cross Retail Park on your right.
- The road splits with grass verge in the middle, at the end of the road, turn right at the roundabout staying on the A422.
- At the traffic lights adjacent to the Barley Mow pub, turn left on the A422 Stratford Road.
- You will pass through the villages of Drayton and Wroxton.
- Stay on the A422 passing signs for Balscote, Alkerton and Shenington.
- After you pass Upton House on your left, the road bends round to the left, as the A422 goes into a sharp right hand bend, take the left turning into Sugarswell Lane.
- Follow this road until you come to a staggered crossroads and take the right hand turning into Shenington Lane.
- As the road descends, look out for the right hand turning on the bend to Winchcombe Farm.

### From Tysoe village

From Main Street through the village, take the turning into Middleton Close signposted to 'Shennington'[sic] follow the road up hill and the turning to Winchcombe Farm is on the left immediately after the first bend.

### **Winchcombe Farm:**

Please adhere to the site 10mph speed limit for everyone's safety.

As you head down our driveway (it's about half a mile long) you will pass over a cattle grid. Please take care as the sheep and lambs roam around and occasionally escape over the cattle grid.

Before you pass over the second cattle grid you will see a sign directing you to turn right in front of the duck pond. Follow the gravel track over the pond and follow the signs to the lodges and treehouse.

### **For George's Getaway and Ben's Burrow, turn left:**

**George's Getaway** - turn left and head down the track and you will see the lodge immediately in front of you.

**Ben's Burrow** – turn left and you will almost immediately see the allocated parking spaces for this lodge. You will then see signposted some steps – go down these steps and then turn right to find the front door (an alternative entrance with no steps can be made available for guests with limited mobility or wheelchair users).

### **For Will's Tree House, the Chicken Shed Lodge and Bob's Lodge, turn right:**

**Will's Tree House** guests are advised to unload their vehicle and enter the property initially (with luggage) from the ramp, which you will see immediately as you turn right.

**The Chicken Shed Lodge** is the first property on the right hand side immediately after the ramp to the tree house.

**Bob's Lodge** is the second property on the right hand-side.

### **Additional parking:**

There is plenty of additional parking if you turn left at the T-junction and park by the gate to the alpacas' paddock.
